Go North of Georgetown on I35 to Exit 168. Go North on frontage 1 mile to FM 972, Turn right onto FM 972. Go 1.33 miles to CR 141. Turn right onto CR141. Go .7 miles to the entrance at 655 CR 141. Look for a metal framed sign with Albrecht on it.. Turn right into driveway and go .36 miles to end. The field will be in front of you on the other side of the trees.

Simple Rules:

- Planes: EF-1 aircraft following NMPRA rules
- Propeller: Only APC 8 X 8 props may be used.
- Fuel: Generator Provided, if needed.
- Fees: **\$20.00** per pilot, per class. Includes lunch ticket.
- Rewards: Mostly Bragging Rights. Will recognize Fastest Lap Time, and 1st through 3rd.
- Course: Two-pylon, 400 ft. must fly out over the pylon area
- Heats: 4-plane heats, Standing start, Ten Lap Heats.
- Inspection: All planes will be inspected for compliance with NMPRA rules.

These events will be in compliance with the AMA Safety Code.
