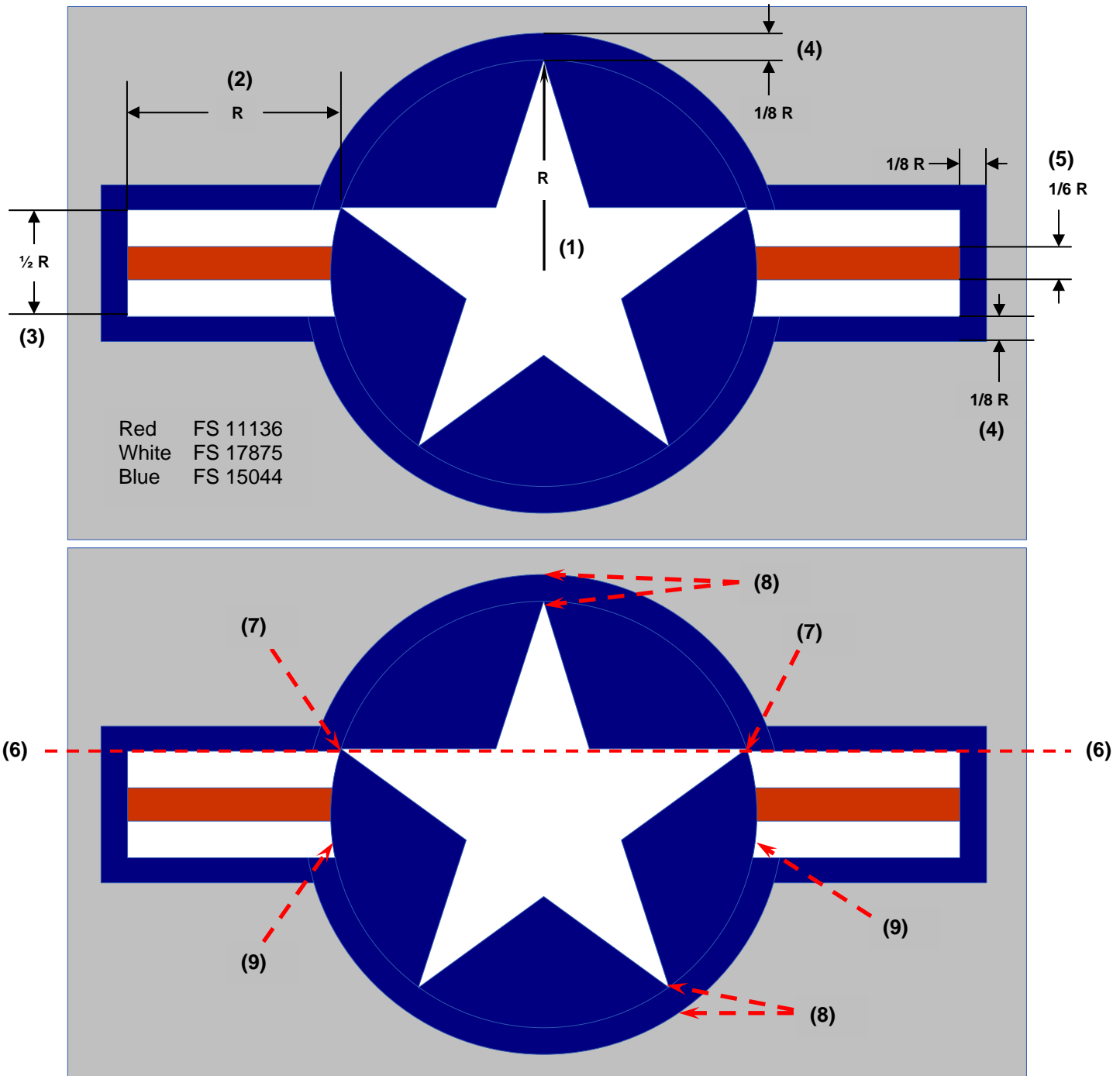


Judges' Quick Reference Sheet

- (1) Star radius = R
- (2) Bar length = R
- (3) Bar height = $\frac{1}{2} R$
- (4) Bar and Star Surround = $\frac{1}{8} R$
- (5) Red stripe = $\frac{1}{6} R$ or $\frac{1}{3}$ width of white bar. White and red stripes are the same width as each other, just like the stripes on the US flag.



- (6) Bars and the shoulders of the Star form a horizontal line
- (7) Star tips and bars touch
- (8) Star tips do not touch the outer edge of the circle (outer edge of surround).
- (9) Inner edge of bars meet star circumference NOT outer edge of surround.
