Taipan 1.5 marine diesel	Mk.1 No exhaust manifold
GB 'Southern Cross' 3.5 diesel	One of only a couple
GB 2.5 'Simple Diesel'	Prototype, no further development
GB 2.5 long-stroke	Gordon's last design, only 3 or 4 made
GB 2.5 TR	Produced with help from David Owen; ~15 varying examples
GB 'Experimental 1cc diesel'	Not made in quantity
Doonside Elfin 149	<i>Check origin - possibly one of Gordon's. Not Russian.</i>
GB Elfin 1.8 replica	
GB 250 replica	Around 140 made
Owen 2.8SP #2	Has '003' tag, '1' on lug, '2' on backplate and front housing
Owen 2.8SP	<i>Production? Webbing on case. '2' on lug. 'G2' underneath. RC carb.</i>
Comet 250	Fred Small engine; early version
Ohlsson 23 copy	Australian, mid-late '40s
Delta 490 (x2)	Silver head. Rare. First version
Delta 490	Red head. 2nd version
Delta 490 (x2)	3rd version
McCulloch 2cc diesel	<i>see MEN article. About 12 made</i>
