Also we partnered with the Twisted Sticks to man the Expo gate for donations. This effort proved very profitable. We are planning to share the profits with the Twisted Sticks. The amount is a subject of discussion in the next meeting. Thank you Tom and Daniell, Larry and others TW members for contributing to our event efforts! This past Winter we partnered for their indoor event! Maybe we should do this type of thing more often?

**The Expo exceeded our income goals.** While the weather forecast appeared to initially keep attendance low, we still had a good turn out on Saturday.

**Out on the Expo flight line,** it was slow on Thursday. Thursdays are typically a "test and tune" day. This concept is to allow our pilots some time to maiden and test different settings, etc. w/o having a large spectator crowd around. It has worked well for many of us. However, it has recently come to my attention that not many of the pilots were aware of this opportunity. This is airspace where we can spend the majority of our time helping each other solve issues w/o having to cater to or endangering spectators. Please feel free to take advantage of these test and tune days. They are for all of us no matter what type of plane you are flying.

Also, it has been brought to my attention that during Expo events the larger plane pilots may be driving away the other flyers. At the Expo event, we have always allocated time for all flyers of all types of planes and helis, including drones. At this year's Expo, we even set up the drone race course for the one drone racer that showed up! If you want some airspace, please feel free step up to the flightline. We will get you flying! Don't feel intimidated by the larger and faster planes. If you feel you need some airspace dedicated to you alone for a maiden flight or testing, please feel free to ask. The Jet Guys at the Expo are there for a reason. To keep the spectators there, they fill the airspace when things are dead. If the Jet Guys see someone else ready to fly, they gladly slip back in the shade and cater to the spectators' questions. The RC Expos are for all of us!

**The new car track is an interesting situation.** I was told by one person "it is still too small." Then 5 minutes later, I was told "it is too big!" Wished these folks were around when we do the work! However, we can look for tight spots in the track and put in a few shortcuts. Plans are to add some clay to stiffen the track surface. I would like to see a lap counter as prices have come down.

**Not much drone activity going on.** We have the gates, pylons and a nice place for drone racing. What's it going to take to get the drone racing going at the Baldwin RC Park?
