THE EAGLE IS MADE FROM FOUR KINDS OF WOOD: Balsa, Bass, Birch, and various plywoods. Each of these woods has its own characteristic end grain pattern (as viewed from the end) which has been drawn on the plans. You can easily use these patterns to identify what kind of wood is shown for a part if you are in doubt.
